election commitment by Member for Barker Tony Pasin. The research centre - one of two

proposed in Australia - is expected to drive cutting edge research into softwood plantations and processing. Mr Bignell's office yesterday told The Border Watch the minister could not comment on "budget initiatives".

According to Mr Pasin yesterday, the project - which has received \$2m from Federal Government coffers was steadily progressing with an agreement brokered to house the institute in the University of SA Mount Gambier campus.
